Berwyn, PA (November 20, 2015) Former Public Works Director, Scott Cannon turned himself over to the Tredyffrin Township Police Department for processing on Friday, November 20, 2015.

The charges brought by the State Attorney General's office arise from facts that were disclosed publicly in February 2014 during a meeting of the Board of Supervisors following the Township's own internal investigation. The Township is unaware of any allegations of violations other than those disclosed in February 2014.

In January 2014, the Township was made aware of acts that are alleged to have been committed by Mr. Cannon in October 2012. The Township notified the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection immediately following the Township's discovery of the allegations, and the Township fully cooperated with their investigation. Following an internal investigation, Mr. Cannon was separated from employment on February 10, 2014.

At the Tredyffrin Board of Supervisor's meeting on February 10, 2014, following Cannon's termination, a public statement was read informing the public of the incidents leading to the separation, after it had been decided that the public had a right to know about potential environmental pollution.

Any further information relating to the arrest and prosecution should be referred to the State Attorney General's Office.
