

Notice to Permit Holders

State Code Requirements

- 1- Enclosed please find (2) two copies of the approved permit for which you have applied. (1) One record copy and (1) one for posting on site. Permits not posted are considered a code violation. (Fines may result)
- 2- A set of approved construction documents have been returned and shall remain on site until construction is complete. (Where applicable)
- 3- A copy of the approved Energy Conservation Report is also enclosed and shall remain on site until the energy inspection is complete and approved. No photos will be accepted for this inspection. (Where applicable)
- 4- Attached to the approved Energy Report is a Thermal Energy Certificate that will be initialed by both permit holder and inspector once the energy inspection is satisfied and shall be permanently attached to the electrical service panel.

Township Requirements

- 1- All disturbed soils as a result of excavation and or construction equipment shall be stabilized with hay or mulched while construction is ongoing. Periodic grading will required additional mulching if necessary.
- 2- Only Master Plumbers or Companies with a Master Plumber on staff shall be permitted to alter sanitary drain or domestic water distribution systems.
- 3- All Contractor and or Sub contractor requiring permits shall have a current registration at the time of permit application. Current insurance information shall be required at the time of registration. Faxing insurance info may delay the registration approval process.
