### **PATRIOTS PATH PLAN PUBLIC HEARING - FEB 22, 2010**

The Board of Supervisors has scheduled a **public hearing for Monday, February 22, 2010** to continue the adoption process of the Patriot's Path Plan. The BOS meeting begins at 7:30 pm. The Patriots Path is a proposed trail network in East Whiteland Township, Malvern Borough and Tredyffrin Township that will connect area historic sites with American Revolutionary War significance via the Chester Valley Trail. With the assistance of Chester County and a professional consultant, the three municipalities have developed a draft plan and study for the Patriots Path. The goal is to adopt a plan that will amend the 2009 Comprehensive Plan to include the Patriots Path plan.

There are two segments to the Patriots Path within Tredyffrin Township:

- The Valley Forge Segment: 1.8 mile connection from the Chester Valley Trail to the Valley Forge National Historical Park in Tredyffrin Township
- The Cedar Hollow Segment: a 1.8 mile connection from the Chester Valley Trail to the Cedar Hollow Preserve and the Cool Valley Preserve via the Warner Spur Trail and then extending an additional mile westward into East Whiteland to connect with the Valley Creek Segment.

### **SNOW PLOWING**

There are still a few months of winter weather ahead of us. The Public Works Department will be out plowing and salting to address winter storms. To keep the roads and motorists safe during these times, please observe the following:

Don't place trash cans in the street – please place them behind the curb or edge of paving, and do not park on the streets during storms. In order to park on the street during a storm, a winter parking pass is required. Your request will be evaluated, and if approved a parking pass will be issued.

### **LOCAL SERVICES TAX (LST)**

Every individual who engages in an occupation within the Township of Tredyffrin shall pay a local services tax to the Township in the amount of \$52 per person per calendar year. This tax shall be used for police, fire or emergency services, road maintenance or real estate tax reduction purposes.

The LST applies to any person engaged in any trade, profession, business or undertaking of any type, kind or character, including services, domestic or other, carried on or performed within the corporate limits of the Township, whether in the employ of another or self-employed for which compensation is charged or received, whether by means of salary, wages, commission, fees or otherwise, for services rendered.
