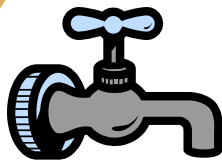

Extraneous flows and what they mean to you...

Sanitary sewer systems are designed to convey wastewater flows such as water from your bath, shower, toilet, washing machine and dishwasher to a sewage treatment facility. What are these extraneous flows, and why are they a problem? When sump pumps, downspouts, basement drains, or window well drains are connected to the sanitary sewer, they are clear water flows which should not be entering the sanitary sewer system. These flows tax the sewer system, and more importantly, are treated at the sewage treatment plant. The more gallons of water that are treated, the more it costs.

So by reducing these types of flows, costs are reduced and the environment is benefited. So please remember; do not connect your sump to the sewer system, make sure your sewer clean out has a cap and is 6" above the ground. Also, leaky faucets cost you money in water bills, and cause the treatment plant to treat otherwise clean water.

Fall Leaf Sites Schedule

ORDINANCE REMINDERS

ALARM SYSTEM: Tredyffrin Township Ordinance HR-365 regarding the use of Alarm Systems, requires every alarm system for residential or commercial properties to have a permit for use. These permits are non-transferable, and if a permit is not obtained, the property owners will be subject to doubled fines. Property owners have until December 31, 2009 to obtain a permit.

The alarm system policy, application, and fee schedule can be accessed from the Township website for your convenience.

POOL WATER DISCHARGE: The discharge of any sewage or industrial waste, including swimming pool water to a water of the Commonwealth without a permit is a violation of the Clean Streams Law.

For information on how to properly dispose of swimming pool water or to report anyone improperly disposing of swimming pool water without a permit, contact the Township Public Works Department at 610-408-3620.

PROJECTS AROUND THE TOWNSHIP:

Sidewalks Project: Township will receive up to \$2.8 Million in federal funding for construction of sidewalks along Conestoga, Old Lancaster, Howellville, and Irish Roads. As this project continues to move forward, PADOT will initiate project advertisement and selection of a contractor by the end of 2009. Construction is anticipated to take place between spring and fall of 2010.

Maude, Lisa, Rochsolach & Vincent Road Stormwater Drainage Project: The Township will receive up to \$523,597 in federal funding for construction of a neighborhood stormwater drainage improvement project in the area northeast of Paoli. The Township has already obtained a contractor to install the proposed improvements. Work is scheduled to begin in early November and expected to take approximately 12 weeks, weather permitting, until substantial completion.

S.R. 252/ AMTRAK Grade Crossing Project: Tredyffrin Township has started the process to obtain a consultant firm to conduct a Feasibility Study to evaluate alternatives to address existing concerns pertaining to the AMTRAK Grade Crossing (Bridge), located just north of the intersection of S.R. 30 and S.R. 252. Once onboard, it is anticipated that the consultant firm will communicate with interested stakeholders and residents in the Paoli area to consider alternatives to address traffic congestion, pedestrian mobility and safety, as well as potential solutions to modify or replace the existing bridge structure. The S.R. 252/ AMTRAK Grade Crossing Feasibility Study is expected to get underway before the end of 2009 and anticipating a Draft Report in the summer 2010. The Feasibility Study and future Preliminary Design portions
