POLICE UPDATE

CHANGE IN FALSE ALARM FEES

The Tredyffrin Township Ordinance HR-365 regarding the use of Alarm Systems in Tredyffrin Township, requires every alarm system for residential or commercial properties to have a permit for use. These permits are non-transferable, and if a permit is not obtained, the property owners will be subject to doubled fines. Property owners have until October 31, 2009 to obtain a permit. Please note there is also a change in fees for false activations. A copy of the application can be printed from the Township website: www.tredyffrin.org/pdf/police/alarm-permit-application.pdf

Alarm Users Permit Fee \$25 (one-time fee)
Senior citizen waiver 65+

Residential Property: (fees per calendar year)

- 1st false alarm Warning
- 2nd false alarm \$50 per alarm
- 3rd false alarm \$75 per alarm
- 4th false alarm \$100 per alarm
- 5th false alarm \$125 per alarm
- 6th false alarm \$150 per alarm
- 7th and subsequent false alarms \$175 per alarm

Commercial Property: (fees per calendar year)

- 1st false alarm Warning
- 2nd false alarm Warning
- 3rd false alarm \$200 per alarm
- 4th false alarm \$300 per alarm
- 5th false alarm \$500 per alarm
- 6th false alarm \$750 per alarm
- 7th and subsequent false alarms..... \$1,000 per alarm
