



Paoli Accessibility Improvements Project

October 2018 Update:

The Paoli Station Accessibility Improvement Project has advanced construction on major components of the improvement project including steel erection of the south (inbound to Philadelphia) stair/elevator tower, excavation and foundations for the north (outbound to Harrisburg) stair/elevator tower, installation of foundation supports and elevator pits for the center high level platform and ongoing modifications to the rail infrastructure (track, overhead catenary and signal) to accommodate these new structures.

Over the last month, installation of the center high level platform panels began and continue to be installed, masonry work continues in the North Tower, stair/elevator tower and overhead pedestrian bridge have been erected. The timeline for the Path of Travel is scheduled to be completed before the end of this year.
