

Act 247 Review

- The Board of Supervisors initiated the Act 247 review process at their April 19 meeting.
- The draft plan was forwarded to adjoining municipalities, TESD, and the CCPC for review and comments on April 20.
- The full draft plan was made available for public review on the Township website or via hard copy at the Township office during the week of April 19.







Act 247 Review

- The mandatory 45 day review period as prescribed by the MPC runs through June 4.
- Any comments received during this time will be compiled and considered for inclusion in the final document.
- A public hearing to consider the formal adoption of the plan is tentatively scheduled for June
 21.
