Dear Mr. Martin:

This letter is to inform you of PennDOT's recent mailing of Notice of Intent to Enter letters to some of your constituents for field surveys to be performed for the Paoli Station Highway Improvements Project in Tredyffrin Township, Chester County. The purpose of this project is to construct a new functioning bridge structure along Relocated North Valley Road over Amtrak's train tracks, to improve the configuration of Central Ave. with a roundabout to relieve vehicular congestion and to improve bicycle and pedestrian access to the station. New signing, pavement markings and ADA facilities will be provided where applicable.

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Eminent Domain Code permits entry upon private property to enable the department to conduct this operation.

The Notice of Intent to Enter letter emphatically states that the need for the department to access property at this stage of the project is no indication that an acquisition will be necessary. However, the language is, by necessity, is official in tone and may generate some concern.

This is the best manner by which the citizen can obtain as much information as needed about the project from the person most knowledgeable about it.
