The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) in accordance with 33 CFR Part 325, Appendix C (Processing Department of Army Permits: Procedures for the Protection of Historic Properties; Final Rule 1990; with current Interim Guidance Document dated January 06, 2009) has enclosed for your review a Declaration of Restrictive Covenant for Conservation for the portions of the Walker Historic Site which is within the USACE permit area.

We request your review of the referenced documentation and your concurrence in our conclusion that the Walker Historic Site, which is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, will not be adversely affected by the proposed permit action in compliance with Appendix C of 33 CFR Part 325 (7)(c).
