What is TTTV?

The mission of Tredyffrin Township Television is to provide the citizens of the township with the facilities, equipment, training, and support necessary to create, produce and telecast non-commercial television programs by, for and about the township. Such programming will be aimed at the preservation, development and enhancement of the diversity of thought, culture and heritage within the community.

Our curricula are free to Tredyffrin residents and their crewmembers, who need not be Tredyffrin residents.

Every taping, according to the physical demands of the production, requires a certain number of certified crewmembers to safely tape a show. At least three certified crewmembers, one of whom must be the (Tredyffrin resident) Lead Certified Producer, are recommended for a standard quality three-camera studio recording.

The number of crewmembers required for any field production will be determined by the studio manager at the time of the equipment loan. The basic determining factor will always be how many trained people are necessary to keep talent, crew and equipment safe.

Only certified crewmembers may use our facilities and equipment.

Classes are held at the Greenwood Studio in the Tredyffrin Township Municipal Bldg. 1100 DuPortail Rd. in Berwyn, PA 19312.

Students may attend either the weekday 7 PM or Saturday noon class, and that selection may change week to week. Space may be limited to first registrants. Classes may be cancelled if attendance is low.
